Registration	The academic year at the Nancy School of Architecture usually starts on the 2 <sup>nd</sup> week of September and ends on June 30 <sup>th</sup> .  • 1 <sup>st</sup> semester: from the 2 <sup>nd</sup> week of September to January 31 <sup>st</sup> .  • 2 <sup>nd</sup> semester: from the 1 <sup>st</sup> week of February to June 30 <sup>th</sup> .  The School advises the students to come to the International Relations Office	
	before the beginning of the semester to complete the registration process.  Incoming students are asked to bring in:	
	<ul> <li>1 passports size pictures;</li> <li>copy of their identity card (UE) / passport and visa (other countries);</li> <li>copy of their student card from the sending institution;</li> <li>a insurance certificate of liability (assurance responsabilité civile).</li> <li>an European Health Insurance Card;</li> <li>the foreign students without any European Health Insurance Card will have to choose a health insurance payment center in France :</li> </ul>

	The examinations are usually held in winter (January and February), summer (June and July) and autumn (September and October).	
Orientation sessions for Erasmus incoming students	A 'Welcome Day' is organized in general at the end of September.	
Language courses for incoming students	Free French courses (30 hrs) are organized at the beginning of september and can allow the obtaining of 3 ECTS.  The enrolment is compulsory (only students with a good French level can be exempt from these courses).  The first session is a French language level test.  A mentoring is also organized by a teacher (30 hrs) and some students.  Please ask about it to the International Relations Office.
