E MADRID03); - family name; - first name; - sex; - one valid e-mail address; - period of stay (1st semester, 2nd semester. full academic year).

<p>Registration</p>	<p>The above mentioned documents should be signed and stamped by the Erasmus Coordinators and should reach the International Office:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - before June 3rd, 2019 for students coming in the 1st semester or full academic year; - before November 4th, 2019 for students coming in the 2nd semester. <p>The academic year at the Nancy School of Architecture usually starts on the 2nd week of September and ends on June 30th.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st semester : from the 2nd week of September to January 31st. • 2nd semester : from the 1st week of February to June 30th. <p>The School advises the students to come to the International Relations Office before the beginning of the semester to complete the registration process.</p> <p>Incoming students are asked to bring in :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 passports size pictures; • copy of their identity card (UE) / passport and visa (other countries); • copy of their student card from the sending institution; • a insurance certificate of liability (assurance responsabilité civile). • an European Health Insurance Card; • the foreign students without any European Health Insurance Card will have to choose a health insurance payment center in France : <p>LMDE (La Mutuelle Des Etudiants) : 9 rue Maurice Barrès 54000 NANCY https://www.lmde.fr/</p> <p>MGEL (Mutuelle Générale des Etudiants de l'Est) : 3 rue des Carmes 54000 NANCY et 3 Bd des Aiguillettes 54500 VANDOEUVRE https://www.mgel.fr/</p> <p>The foreign students can also subscribe in one of these centers a complementary health insurance for a better cover of their medical fees, an insurance certificate of liability, a housing insurance.</p> <p>The examinations are usually held in winter (January and February), summer (June and July) and autumn (September and October).</p>	
<p>Orientation sessions for Erasmus incoming students</p>	<p>A 'Welcome Day' is organized in general at the end of September.</p>	
<p>Language courses for incoming students</p>	<p>Free French courses (30 hrs) are organized at the beginning of september and can allow the obtaining of 3 ECTS.</p> <p>The enrolment is compulsory (only students with a good French level can be exempt from these courses).</p> <p><u>The first session is a French language level test.</u></p> <p><u>A mentoring is also organized by a teacher (30 hrs) and some students.</u></p> <p><u>Please ask about it to the International Relations Office.</u></p>
